

KLONDIKE CYCLE ROAD RACE, REDCAR & CLEVELAND AREA – Sunday 29th April 2018

PLEASE NOTE: A 'ROLLING ROAD CLOSURE' ALLOWS THE ROAD TO BE SHUT BY THE MOTO SECTION OF THE POLICE AND TRAFFIC MARSHALLS - FOR AROUND 10-15 MINUTES, THIS ALLOWS THE RIDERS TO PASS SAFELY; THE ROAD THEN RE-OPENS ONCE THEY HAVE GONE PAST, MEANING MINIMAL DISTRIBUTION TO THE ROADS WHILST THE KLONDIKE GP IS TAKING PLACE.
